

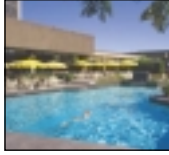
Hotel Reservations

Confirmation of your reservation will be sent to you directly by the hotel. Include a first night deposit in Canadian or US funds with your request. A cheque or credit card number are acceptable. **Refund of deposit** will be made up to **72 hours** prior to the date of arrival. Reservations must be received in **Montréal by July 11, 2003**. The congress will release its block of rooms after that date. Rooms will be assigned on a first-come, first-served basis. **You must notify the housing bureau of any changes or cancellation.**

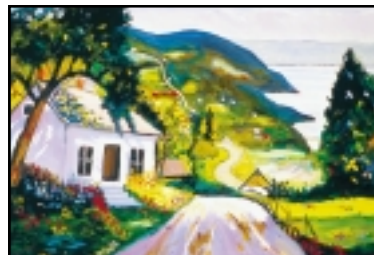

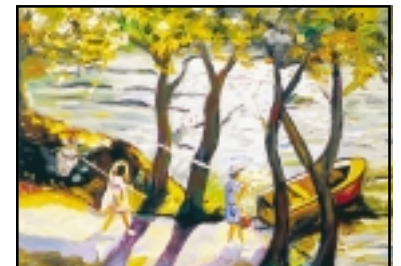
